



Kenneth B. Gordon, MD

Kenneth Gordon is a professor of dermatology at the Medical College of Wisconsin in Milwaukee, WI, USA.

Over the past 25 years, Dr. Gordon's clinical and research interests have focused on developing novel immunotherapies for psoriasis.

He has led multiple clinical trials nationally and internationally and published more than 250 papers, including first-author publications in *The New England Journal of Medicine*, *The Lancet*, and *JAMA*.

Dr. Gordon graduated from the Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons in New York City, NY, USA. He was trained in internal medicine at the Beth Israel Hospital in Boston, MA, and in dermatology at Northwestern University in Evanston, IL. Dr. Gordon followed dermatology training with a postgraduate fellowship in basic immunology at Northwestern and continued as a faculty member on a Dermatology Foundation Career Development Award, studying immunological mechanisms in cutaneous biology. Dr. Gordon has served as the Center for Clinical Research Director at Northwestern and, until recently, the chair of dermatology at the Medical College of Wisconsin.
