Dr. Carolyn Jack (MDCM, PhD, FRCPC) is an Assistant Professor at McGill University, and a Junior Scientist at the Infectious Diseases and Immunity in Global Health Program of the Research Institute of the McGill University Health Centre. In 2018, Dr. Jack founded the McGill University Hospital Network Center of Excellence for Atopic Dermatitis, the first tertiary care centre in Canada dedicated to adult atopic dermatitis. She is the co-founder of EczemaQ, an award-winning mobile health application, and the registered non-profit Patient

Advisory Committee known as Eczéma Québec. As a Clinician Scientist, her research goal is to identify disease-modifying interventions in chronic atopic dermatitis.
