



Claus Johansen, MSc PhD DMSc

Claus Johansen is a professor and head of the research laboratory at the Department of Clinical Medicine at Aarhus University Hospital in Aarhus, Denmark.

Dr. Johansen's research area of interest is the immunological processes driving inflammatory skin diseases, especially psoriasis, with a special focus on signal transduction and the role of specific lymphocyte subtypes in the skin.

He received the New Investigator Award from the European Skin Research Foundation in 2009 and the LEO Foundation Gold Award for outstanding young skin researchers in 2011. He is a member of the European Society for Dermatological Research (ESDR), the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (EADV), and a board member of the Nordic Dermatology Associations Research Committee. Dr. Johansen has more than 100 peer-reviewed scientific publications.

Dr. Johansen earned his MSc in molecular biology from Aarhus University in 1999 and obtained his PhD and doctoral degree of medical science from Aarhus University in 2003 and 2010, respectively.
