

Natasha Mesinkovska, MD, PhD is Director of Clinical Research in Dermatology at the University of California Irvine and serves as NAAF's Chief Scientific Officer. Dr. Mesinkovska is a board-certified UCI Health dermatologist who specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of skin disorders, including skin cancer.

She earned her medical degree at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minn., after receiving a doctorate in cancer biology from Wayne State University in Detroit, Mich. She

completed an internal medicine internship at the Cleveland Clinic in Ohio, where she also completed a residency in dermatology and a fellowship in dermatopathology.

She also serves as vice chair for clinical research in the UCI School of Medicine's Department of Dermatology.
