Valeria Aoki and Maria Notomi Sato), after a fellowship in the laboratory of research in exosomes, at VUmc University medical center, Netherlands (2018), which was finished in 2023. She is currently an associate researcher in the Laboratory of Immunodeficiencies and Dermatology (LIM-56), Dermatology Department, University of Sao Paulo Medical School, Sao Paulo, Brazil.
