



### Lev Pavlovsky, MD PhD

Lev Pavlovsky is a clinical associate professor of dermatology at the Sackler Faculty of Medicine, Tel Aviv University, and director of the Psoriasis Treatment Unit and Outpatient Clinics in the Division of Dermatology at Rabin Medical Center in Petah Tikva, Israel.

His clinical and research expertise lies in immunobiological therapies for psoriasis, and he has served as principal investigator in numerous international clinical trials in this field.

Dr. Pavlovsky is the secretary of the Psoriasis Society of the Israel Society of Dermatology and Venereology (ISDV) and serves as Israel's national representative to the Skin Inflammation and Psoriasis International Network (SPIN) of the ISDV. Dr. Pavlovsky has authored more than 60 scientific publications and book chapters and was a contributing author of the Israeli clinical guidelines for psoriasis treatment. His primary research interests include inflammatory skin diseases, with a focus on the immunopharmacology of psoriasis.

He earned his MD and PhD through the combined program at Ben-Gurion University of the Negev and completed his dermatology residency at Rabin Medical Center. He pursued advanced training in phototherapy and psoriasis at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York City, NY, USA, under the mentorship of Professor Mark Lebwohl.
