



Andrew Pink, BMedSci (Hons) BMBS PhD MRCP (UK)

Andrew Pink is a consultant dermatologist and the director of the adult clinical trials unit at St John's Institute of Dermatology, Guy's and St Thomas' Hospitals, in London, UK. He is an adjunct reader in clinical and therapeutic dermatology at King's College London and deputy director of the NIHR South London Commercial Research Delivery Centre (CRDC) based out of Guy's and St. Thomas' Hospitals.

His clinical and academic interests focus on inflammatory skin disease and translational medicine, primarily in eczema and psoriasis.

Dr. Pink is a councillor in the International Eczema Council and International Psoriasis Council, chair of the Annual UK Dermatology Course for Consultants, ex-Honorary Secretary of the St John's Dermatological Society, and Associate Editor of the clinical trials section of the *British Journal of Dermatology (BJD)*. He regularly acts as a NICE clinical expert.

Dr. Pink helped to develop and leads a national multidisciplinary eczema service and a large and active trials unit (phase II-IV) at St. John's. He has acted as chief investigator on multiple trials examining novel therapies emerging in psoriasis, eczema, and prurigo nodularis and is chief investigator for the BEACON trial, the first global multiarm multistage platform trial in atopic eczema.
